As you may be aware, all of the Directors of the JSH Relocation Project resigned on April 1st, 2017. Their action was out of concern over their continued ability to obtain alignment amongst the contributors and the general membership for the vision of the new center and its required governance. In particular, the lack of support from the general membership to amend the JSH's Constitution to encourage active equal participation in JSH's governance from large contributors ("Patrons") was cited as an obstacle to their abilities to continue to lead the Relocation Project.

Under the terms of the Pledge Agreements, the donors have the absolute right to direct the usage of their donations by the JSH. As such, the JSH is obligated to offer you either:

- 1) an opportunity to direct your full donation to another 501c3 charitable organization of your choice; or
- 2) an opportunity to amend your pledge so that the donation can be used for other JSH purposes, such as for the General Fund, the Pathshala Fund, or the Building Fund, among others; or
- 3) an opportunity to keep your funds with JSH relocation project for new temple and facility; or
- 4) a full refund of your donation which will result in JSH issuing you a Form 1099. Please be aware that choosing this option, a refund of donation, (1) may lead to tax consequences; (2) may require you to amend your tax return; (3) return of contribution in the subsequent year will be income but only to the extent that deducting the contribution reduced tax liability and (4) we highly recommend you to consult with a tax advisor or tax consultant.

If the pledge agreement is signed but amount has not been paid to JSH in that case the pledge document is no more valid unless you want to keep it for option 3 above.

Please note that in all cases, the entire amount of your donation will be available. The Directors of the Relocation Project personally absorbed all of the expenses to date, which have been approximately \$154,000, so 100% of all contributions are available for refund or direction to other causes as set forth above.

Please contact JSH.RelocationRefund@Jain-Houston.org within 45 days from the date of the letter and inform us of your choice. If we do not hear from you, we will keep your donation for new temple relocation project.
